Attach files in Sumac


New feature


With the Sumac 4.5.19 release comes the ability to upload a file directly into your database!

Until now, a user could link a file in Sumac, but the file still 'lived' on the user's computer. If the file was moved or deleted, this would break the link in Sumac, making it difficult to find the file again. This new upload ability means that files can be uploaded to the database, are included in Sumac backups, and stay available even if deleted from the user computer. The file size limit for each file uploaded is 16MB.

Additional Notes

The file upload functionality is not available in Case Management or Custom areas of Sumac yet, but this will be coming in the new year! This functionality is only available for clients using our cloud-hosting service. If you have a self-hosted database, please contact our Sales team to explore upgrading to cloud-hosting to take advantage of this new feature!






Clickable Dashboard

New Feature


In this release we updated the Sumac Dashboard to provide access to the Dashboard statistics with just one click. Whenever you see an item in the Dashboard is underlined, this means you can click the item to see the details behind that statistic. For example, if your Dashboard shows you that two reminders are overdue, click the "2" and you will see exactly which reminders need your attention.



Exciting enhancement to built-in reports

There are two significant changes made to Sumac's built-in reports that make it easier for you to access contacts right from your reports:


- 1. Contact IDs and Names are now clickable. When you run a report that includes a list of contact names and information, you can click any contact's name to open their contact record and see more information about them.
- 2. A new "Show Contact(s)" button in the bottom-right corner of the report allows you to quickly show all contacts referenced in the report in a single list!




Executive Summary Report

New Feature

We've added a new Executive Summary report that Sumac can email directly to your Executive Director, Fundraisers, or Board Members for you automatically. This report helps you effortlessly share important information about Donation Statistics with your team.




To turn this feature on and customize who will receive the report, go to Utilities > Customize Database > Preference. On the Reports tab, you will find the new 'Executive Summary' configuration settings.



Integration with Outlook Calendar

New Feature

In previous versions of Sumac, you could easily add Meetings to your Google Calendar. In this release, we have extended that capability to Outlook calendars as well.



New options for Basic and Advanced searching

This release provides a new quick Basic Search field to provide you with fast access to the most common search option in each area of Sumac. We have also separated our search capability into Basic and Advanced searching.

Basic Search


You can run a quick search using the Basic Search field. For example, in the Contact list, you can type a contact's first name into the Basic Search field to quickly search for contacts.

Advanced Search

Whenever you want to search more more detailed options, expand the "Advanced" menu to find all other searches and filters you may need to perform more advanced searches.

This change makes it easier and faster to run simple searches in the database, and provides more space in each area of Sumac to show you more data in your list!





Office365 email attachment limit increased

In previous versions of Sumac, users who had integrated Sumac with their Office 365 account to send bulk emails were unable to include attachments on bulk emails if the attachment was larger than 3MB. In this release, we have been able to increase this attachment size limit to 24MB.

Quick Install for new users

Installing Sumac on a new computer has never been easier! We have modernized the installation procedure to make installing Sumac for new users or new computers smoother and simpler to follow.
